- The largest federal aid program in schools.
- Established so that all children have a fair, equal and significant opportunity to receive a high quality education.
- Funding is based on an estimate of low-income students, for grades K-5 in the district.
- Used to meet each district and school's unique needs.



## School Wide Title I Program at MCIS

### Eligibility:

Funds are distributed among schools according to poverty levels. Since MCIS is a CEO school, this is determined by using direct certified numbers.

### School Wide Program:

- Generally used in schools with about 40% poverty
- Not required to identify particular children for services
